Shannon Robshaw, MSW, is the Executive Director of the Louisiana Health Care Quality Forum, where she directs all aspects of the organization's daily operations and works with the Board of Directors to plan and implement strategic priorities needed to accomplish the organization's mission of leading evidence-based, collaborative initiatives to improve the health of the people of Louisiana. She formerly served as an Executive Management Officer in the Office of the Secretary of the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals (DHH), where she led the work with stakeholders to develop the Louisiana Health Care Quality Forum (LHCQF). The development of the LHCQF was a recommendation of the Louisiana Health Care Redesign Collaborative, for which Ms. Robshaw provided staff support, including serving as lead staff for the Living with Illness and Disability workgroup. Her additional responsibilities at DHH included leading other departmental and cross-agency transformation initiatives, such as the development of Louisiana's Plan for Access to Mental Health Care and the Louisiana Integrated Treatment Services infrastructure initiative. She also previously served as the Director of Strategic Management and Fund Development for DHH's Office of Mental Health. Prior to her employment with DHH, Ms Robshaw served as the Executive Director of the Mental Health Association in Louisiana, where she established the organization as the prominent leader for mental health issues, building a multi-stakeholder advocacy coalition focused on legislation and policy.
