Ian McCaslin, M.D., M.P.H., is the Director of the MO HealthNet Division, the Missouri Medicaid Program, within the Department of Social Services. In this capacity Dr. McCaslin is responsible for the overall administration of the \$6.9 billion MO HealthNet program, serving approximately 842,000 of Missouri's most vulnerable individuals, including low income elderly, disabled, blind, children, and pregnant women. A native of North Carolina, Dr. McCaslin received his medical degree from the University of South Carolina, with postgraduate training in pediatrics at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and a fellowship in pediatric emergency medicine from Children's National Medical Center in Washington, DC. Additionally, Dr. McCaslin earned a Masters in Public Health with an emphasis in Health Policy from the Harvard School of Public Health. While in Boston Dr. McCaslin was the Medical Director for the New England Alliance for Children's Health, a broad-based coalition advocating for improved financing of and access to health care services for children. Dr. McCaslin's clinical, research, educational, and administrative contributions have focused upon enhanced quality of health care delivery, particularly for low income children. Dr. McCaslin is a Fellow of the American Board of Pediatrics and the American College of Emergency Physicians. He has held faculty appointments at Harvard Medical School, Boston; University of California San Diego School of Medicine, San Diego; and the George Washington University School of Medicine, Washington, DC.
